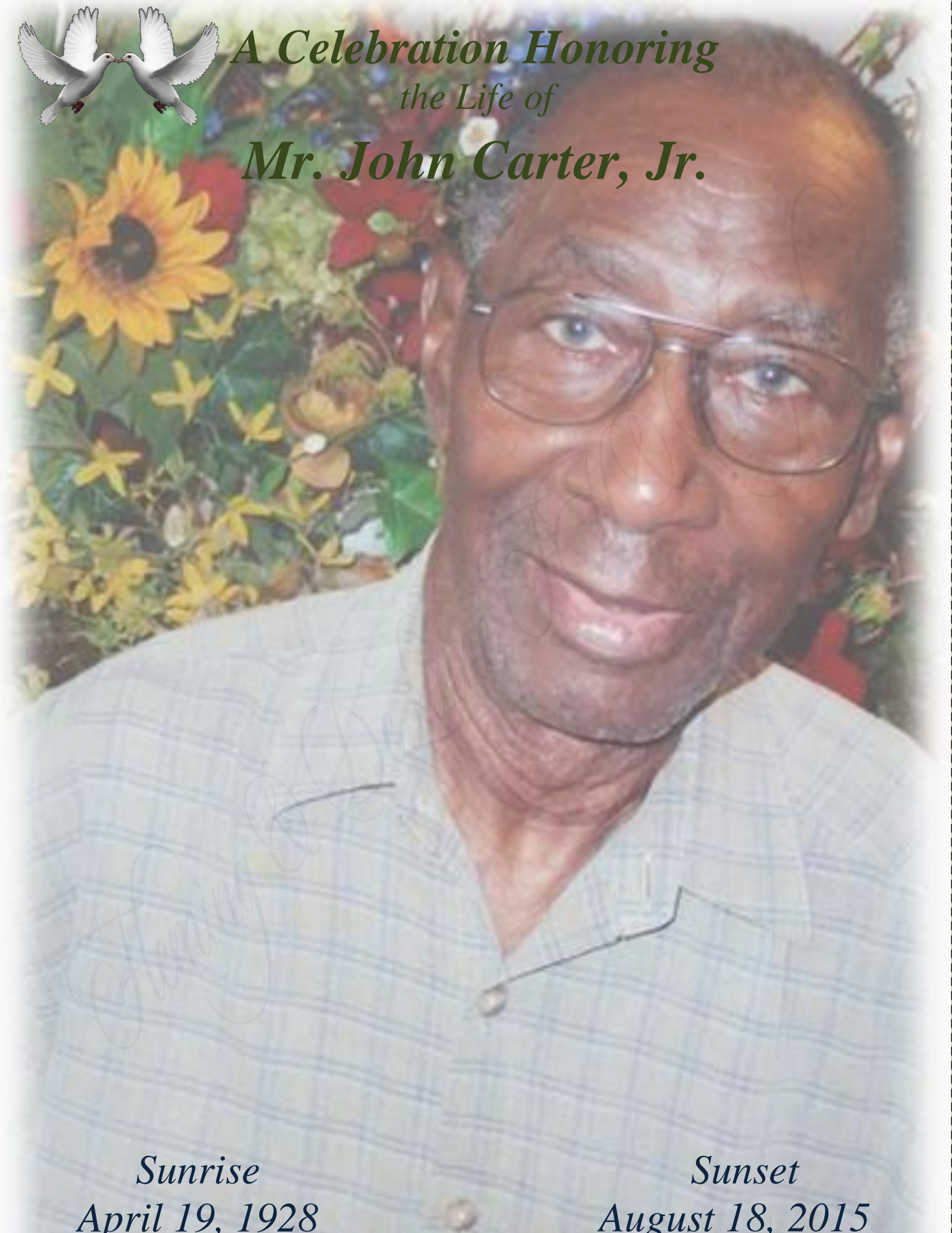

The Obituary

Life's voyage came to an end for Retired Master Sergeant John **"Jackie"** Carter, Jr. on Tuesday, August 18, 2015, at National Healthcare Center in Sumter, South Carolina.
