Mary Belle Davis Mazyck, widow of Robert Mazyck, peacefully departed this earthly life on Saturday, January 17, 2015 at her residence, 1539 Heritage Drive, Manning, South Carolina. She was born on May 3, 1933 in Manning, South Carolina. *Mary* was the youngest daughter of the late Leslie Davis and the late Virginia Smith Davis.

She received her formal education in the public schools of Manning, South Carolina and her Bachelor of Arts Degree from Morris College in Sumter, South Carolina. *Mary* began a long and distinguished teaching career in Clarendon County, South Carolina, Chicago, Illinois and San Francisco, California. She taught for many years in San Francisco before retiring. As a teacher, *Mary* had a zeal for helping youth to obtain an education. Her firm, kind and understanding manner endeared her to many students.

After accepting Christ as her personal Lord and Savior, at an early age, *Mary* joined Elizabeth Baptist Church in Manning, South Carolina where she was a devoted member.
